I have an Iranian Christian friend who has lived in the States since she was 11 years old. She comes from a Muslim family. Her mother lives with her and has attended church with her for several years, but never made a decision to follow Christ. My friend was educated in the States, so her English is probably better than her Farsi, but her mother's language is Farsi. I invited my friend and her mother to attend the Iranian Church last month.
