Once you have started to dialog with a person and you have an idea where their heart is, you can begin to really address their issues and needs. Here are a few common ones.

**1. Someone who has just received Jesus into their lives as Savior needs ASSURANCE.**

They need to have a confident trust or faith, based on scripture, not on feelings or circumstances, that Christ is in their lives and that they have eternal life.

Share one or two Bible verses with them and ask a few questions. Ask them to respond back with their answers. Then send them another verse and some questions.

Example:

Alfred, here are some words and from the Bible and a few questions to think about. Please send me your answers and we can discuss this.

*And this is the testimony: God has given us eternal life, and this life is in his Son. He who has the Son has life; he who does not have the Son of God does not have life. I write these things to you who believe in the name of the Son of God so that you may know that you have eternal life.*

1 John 5:11-13

According to these verses, how do we obtain eternal life?

Who has eternal life?

Is it possible to have received Jesus, to personally believe in the Son and not have eternal life?

**2. Someone who is confident of their salvation but is having trouble living the Christian life, needs to know about the SPIRIT FILLED LIFE**

No one can please God by trying to live a good life in his own strength. Trying to do so will only lead to frustration and failure. It won't help the person if you only tell them to "try harder" or "stop sinning". You will need to teach them how to be controlled and empowered by the Holy Spirit.

**3. Someone who is not yet ready to place their faith in Jesus may need certain parts of the GOSPEL explained in more detail.**

By asking them a few questions you may find that confusion in one of these areas is preventing them from coming to Jesus.

- The nature of God, His love and holiness
- Man's Problem – Sin and Separation from God
- Jesus – who He is, why He came and died on the cross
- The need for each person to make a personal decision
